## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO THE FACILITY

The HARS Aviation Museum is now open for business once again. The health and safety of our visitors and members is paramount, and we have developed a revised COVID-19 Safety Plan in line with the NSW Government's template that was released on 11 September 2021 and the "Roadmap for Easing COVID-19 Restrictions" that was released on 2 October 2021. Following are some aspects of the Plan and Roadmap, and these constitute the Conditions of Entry to the museum, including the embedded Café Connie:

- Visitors and members aged 16 years and above who have received two vaccinations of an approved vaccine will be allowed entry. Visitors and members will be required to show documented proof of the two vaccinations, or an exemption signed by a qualified medical professional.
- If you feel unwell or are displaying symptoms of a cold or flu (fever, cough, sore throat, difficulty breathing etc.), please do not enter the museum. If you look or feel unwell, you will be asked to leave.
- The wearing of a mask before entry to the museum and whilst on the premises is mandatory unless an exemption is held.
- On arrival, visitors and members will be required to sign-in using the Service NSW QR code provided. (Members will also be required to sign-in using the HARS QR code).
- Visitors and members will be asked to undergo a contactless body temperature scan.
- Visitors and members will be asked to sanitise their hands on arrival.
- Visitors and members will be required to practise physical distancing and stay 1.5m apart. We have placed markers on the floor at the reception desk and café to assist with safe physical distancing.
- We encourage all visitors and members to download the COVIDSafe app to their smart phone prior to arrival at the museum.
- Due to the size of our aircraft hangars, a maximum of 500 visitors will be permitted on site at any one time. Café Connie is limited to 50 seated patrons.
- We will be carrying out guided tours, but groups will be limited to a maximum of 20 visitors, plus the guide.
